Billingham Bowling Club Return to Bowls Communication Update 24th May

Billingham Bowling Club is opening all rinks on both bowling greens.

The maximum number of bowlers per green **Must not exceed 30**.

It is vitally important that Social Distancing is maintained and the sanitising protocols are adhered to.

Bookings.

Sessions and Rinks must be pre Booked

Midweek 2 Session per day afternoons and evenings. Afternoon Session 1.00pm to 4.00pm. Evening Session time 6.00pm to 9.00pm.

Weekend 1 session per day Afternoon Session 1.00pm to 4.00pm

Members wishing to book must give contact details when arranging any booking.

To Book: Use the Rink booking folder in the Pavilion

Sessions must be booked at least 24 hours in advance.

All bowlers to be named when booking.

The sessions will not be always overseen by an attendant.

It will be the responsibility of members to ensure all equipment is returned and gates locked.

Important Information

Do not come to the green if you are experiencing any coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms or any cold or flu-like symptoms, in particular a cough or a high temperature. For your own protection, follow the advice about self-isolation.

The Locker rooms are currently closed so dress appropriately – change shoes immediately before and after your game.

It is **important** that all Players maintain Social Distancing and use hand sanitiser regularly. Face coverings are Optional – Unless guidance changes.

Spectators are allowed

All bowlers and spectators to Sign in providing a contact number (Track and trace requirement) Or scan the QR code with your NHS Covid-19 App to check into Billingham Bowling Club.

Locker Rooms, Kitchen and Hall

The Pavilion is open

- Key is available from Key box. Please set alarm and lock up and return key to key box.

The Main Hall and Kitchen are not open.

Locker rooms and toilets are available for use with restricted numbers which are displayed.

Please ensure permitted numbers are not exceeded.

Use sanitisers provided.

Arriving at Green

Please Use Finchale Avenue Entrance only.

Please observe Social Distancing at all times

Sign in providing a contact number (Track and trace requirement) or scan the QR code with your NHS Covid-19 App

Ensure you have your personal hand sanitiser. Weather Conditions may determine if play is possible please use common sense when there is no attendant on duty.

Equipment

Only use your own bowls and bowls equipment.

You will only need Mats and Jack.

Please put a sanitiser at each end and use it.

No Pushers, scoreboard or chalk to be used. (For Social play)

(refer to Bowls England or EBF guidelines for Competition or League play)

Measures can be used but only by the owner of the measure.

If you use lifting aids, cloths or gloves make sure you keep them in your possession.

It is the responsibility of the designated player to collect mats and jack.

After play the designated player must sanitise mats and jack with the spray cleanser provided.

Whilst Playing

Please use sanitiser every end and after handling the mat or jack.

Please observe social distancing at all times.

Maximum of 6 players per rink.

To minimise the risk of any cross contamination players handling the mat and jack **Must** sanitise hands after contact.

When changing ends all players to walk down their left side of green and maintain social distance.

At the end of the game it is the responsibility of the designated player to decontaminate mats and jack.

Leaving the Green

- Ensure all equipment is returned
- Ensure you have all your personal belongings, bowls, shoes and clothing.
- Please dispose rubbish etc or take it home for disposal.
- Ensure Pavilion is alarm is set and door locked key returned to key box.
- Ensure Pavilion Gates are locked.
- Ensure Park Gate is locked.

Remember

- Stay Alert Stay Safe
- Social Distance.
- Use sanitiser every end and after handling the mat or jack.
- Don't handle anything that is not yours.
- Do a mental risk assessment and use common sense.
